Under the overall supervision of the Regional Administrative Officer (RAO) and direct supervision of the CITS Officer, the incumbent shall fulfill the following duties and responsibilities:

- Operates radio networks, telex/fax machines, receives and dispatches messages etc.
- Ensures that all communication equipments are in working condition.
- Performs repairs of radios and related communications equipment, when appropriate; Transmits/receives clear and confidential messages through various facsimile machines;
- Processes and maintains up to date records and logs of all incoming/outgoing traffic, facilitating distribution through hard/soft copies.
- Monitors the VHF communications networks of region including executing plans in times of need/crisis/emergency, as applicable.
- Monitors the HF system for incoming/outgoing voice/data messages from vehicles and other networks covered by the mission and relay information appropriately.
- Monitors mobile vehicle traffic whilst logging in the location and situation of the personnel aboard (convoy tracking);
- Perform any other duties as assigned.

Competencies:

Planning and Organizing: Demonstrated ability to establish priorities and to plan, coordinate and monitor own work plan.

Creativity: Ability to actively seek to improve services, offer new and different options to solve problems/meet client needs, and promote and persuade others to consider new ideas.

Communication: Proven and sustained communication (verbal and written) skills.

Teamwork: Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships in a multi-cultural, multi-ethnic environment with sensitivity and respect for diversity, including gender balance. Places the Organization's agenda before personal agenda.
