Duties and responsibilities:

- All electrical installations within the mission area, ensures the integrity of the materials being used and safety procedures being applied.
- Carry out the daily operations, regulate and maintenance of the electrical systems and equipment as assigned by the electrical supervisor.
- Advises Electrical Supervisor on the requirement of upgrades on electrical systems and coordinates the requirement of spares.
- Implements preventive measure to alleviate and improve downtime during power failures.
- Assists with the required specifications to enable the procurement of equipment and materials.
- Carry out field inspections of equipment and electrical installations. Regarding condition and safety standards applied.
- Repairs electrical faults in switchboards, generators, electric motors and electrical control systems.
- Take responsibility for electrical repairs and overhauls.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
